Good Shepherd Village at Endwell Visitation Fact Sheet-For Skilled Nursing facility Effective 4/1/2021

- In the event of any staff and/or resident cases of Covid-19 at the facility, visitation will be suspended until further notice.
- Visitors and residents must comply with social distancing, hand hygiene, and wear disposable face masks at all times. Masks must be discarded upon exiting the grounds.
- Visitors must be screened for signs/symptoms of COVID-19 including a temperature check and questions regarding possible exposure and travel.
- Outdoor visitation poses a lower risk of transmission due to increases space and airflow, therefore; all visits should be held outdoors whenever practicable.
- In room visitation is allowed beyond end-of life/compassionate care when the county positivity rate is below 10% and >70% of the residents have been vaccinated
- For indoor visitation, visitors are to go directly to the resident room and are not to be walking around the halls or units.
- Close contact is permissible if the resident has been fully vaccinated, with the visitor wearing a well-fitting facemask and hand hygiene is performed before and after
- Visits are by appointment only and are limited to 30 minutes.
- The maximum number of visitors per resident per time slot will be 2. The total number of visitor in the facility during any time slot will not exceed 10
- Visitors under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older.
- Pets are allowed as long as they have been approved through the pet visitation process. Pets must be on a leash of at least 6 feet.
- Documentation on visitors name, address, phone, and e-mail is required.
- Good Shepherd reserves the right to refuse any visitor who refuses to be compliant with any aspect of the visitation guidelines or is under the influence, disruptive or presents a danger to any resident or staff.

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• Per NYS Department of Health quidelines directives, any visitor that fails to adhere to the protocol will be prohibited from visiting for the duration of the COVID-19 state declared public health emergency.

Hand Hygiene: Whether you use soap and water or hand sanitizer, rub your hands together for at least **20 seconds**.

Use hand sanitizer if soap and water are unavailable

- 1. Apply the recommended amount of gel to the palm of one hand.
- 2. Cover all surfaces of the hands and fingers.
- 3. Rub the hands together for approximately 20 seconds.

Proper way to wear mask





Wear a mask that covers your nose and mouth to help protect others in case you're infected with COVID-19 but don't have symptoms

- Wear a mask correctly for maximum protection
- **Don't** put the mask around your neck or up on your forehead
- **Don't** put the mask below your nose or chin.
- Don't touch the mask, and, if you do, wash your hands or use hand sanitizer to disinfect
