

# **Good Shepherd Village at Endwell**

## **Visitation Fact Sheet-For Skilled Nursing facility**

### **Effective 10/1/2020**

- **In the event of any staff and/or resident cases of Covid-19 at the facility, visitation will be suspended until further notice.**
- Visitors and residents must comply with social distancing, hand hygiene, and wear disposable face masks at all times.
- **Visitors must present proof of a negative COVID-19 test within the 7 days prior to each visit.**
- All masks must be discarded upon exiting the grounds.
- Visitors must be screened prior to the visit, including temperature checks.
- Good Shepherd will not permit any in room visitation unless resident is receiving end of life/compassionate care
- Visitation is limited to outdoor areas. Under certain limited circumstances, as we have defined, visitation can be indoors in The Great Room with no more than 10 individuals. The Great Room is well ventilated and will accommodate appropriate social distancing for the number of individuals (not to exceed 10.)
- Limited circumstances include weather conditions (inclement weather; snow, sleet, rain, thunder/lightening, excessively hot or cold temperatures, poor air quality) and an individual residents health status.
- The decision to move visitation indoors requires consultation with the Director of Nursing or The Health Care Administrator.
- Visits are by appointment only and are limited to 30 minutes
- The number of visitors will vary depending on the in-house census
- Visitors must be 18 years of age
- No pets allowed
- Documentation on visitors name, address, phone, and e-mail is required.
- Good Shepherd reserves the right to refuse any visitor who refuses to be compliant with any aspect of the visitation guidelines or is under the influence, disruptive or presents a danger to any resident or staff.

### Effective 10/1/2020

- Per NYS Department of Health guidelines directives, any visitor that fails to adhere to the protocol will be prohibited from visiting for the duration of the COVID-19 state declared public health emergency.

- ❖ In the event of any staff and/or resident cases of Covid-19 at the facility, visitation will be suspended until further notice.

**Hand Hygiene:** Whether you use soap and water or hand sanitizer, rub your hands together for at least **20 seconds**.

**Use hand sanitizer if soap and water are unavailable**

1. Apply the recommended amount of gel to the palm of one hand.
2. Cover all surfaces of the hands and fingers.
3. Rub the hands together for **approximately 20 seconds**.

#### Proper way to wear mask



*Wear a mask that covers your nose and mouth to help protect others in case you're infected with COVID-19 but don't have symptoms*

- Wear a mask in public settings when around people who don't live in your household, especially when it may be difficult for you to stay six feet apart
- Wear a mask correctly for maximum protection
- **Don't** put the mask around your neck or up on your forehead
- **Don't** put the mask below your nose or chin.
- **Don't** touch the mask, and, if you do, wash your hands or use hand sanitizer to disinfect
